Challenge Yourself — Participate in the New Jersey State Police Trooper Youth Week

In 1965, the New Jersey State Police developed a residential youth education program so that students could experience simulated law enforcement training. Trooper Youth Week was designed for both male and female students who have completed their junior year and are entering their senior year of high school.



Curriculum:

The week's activities include lectures and presentations covering many facets of police work and criminal justice. Participants will be exposed to a disciplined quasi-military environment, including military drill in combination with structured fast-moving programs of classroom activities, lectures, films, practical exercises and physical training, simulating the NJSP recruit training experience. The program emphasizes courtesy, professionalism, respect, and teamwork for all youth involved.

Requirements:

- Must have completed junior year and be entering senior year of high school
- Trooper Youth Week Application
- Medical/Insurance/Emergency Information
- Photocopy of Medical Insurance Card (*front/back*)
- Physician Medical Approval Form
- Consent for Photograph & Audio/Visual Release
- Leadership Essay (*500 word minimum*)

- Damaged/Malfunctioning Device and/or Charger
- Reporting a Lost or Stolen Device and/or Charger
- Network, Google, or Email Account Issue
- Software Issue
- Connectivity (Wi-Fi)
- Password Reset
- Other

Once the form is submitted, all updates will be sent to both the student's district and alternate email from devicerepair@ucvts.org.

Check your email regularly!



Submit ASAP for:

- *Faster Turnaround:* Early requests mean quicker responses.
- *Less Stress:* No last-minute rush for you (or us!).
- *Priority Processing:* Avoid delays caused by high submission volumes.

How you can help:

- *Plan Ahead:* Don't wait until the last minute to submit the form.
- *Be Clear:* Fill out the entire form and include as much detail as possible.
- *Check your deadlines:* Note important dates and submit early.
